CLINIC SERVICE

Quality health care service has been provided to 2137 rural and migrant people through our six rural health centers and also organized Ante Natal Camps and General Health Camps to provide quality health care to the deprived section of our society.



VECTOR BORN DISEASE CONTROL ACTIVITIES :

Visited **19,935** residence and covered **59,000** population of ceramic factories and farm areas of Morbi District. 6715 Abet treatments has been provided. We have collected **649** Blood Sample of suspected malaria cases and also supplied RD KITS to **243** patients of Bharatnagar Primary Health Centre at Morbi.

CBCI-CARD RNTCP PROJECT:

Two TB Schemes namely TB Urban Slum and TB/HIV provided TB test and provided medical services at Rajkot City.

Navjeevan Trust rendering, service to 12300 MSM, FSW and Destination migrant population at Rajkot city. We organized 14 Health Camps provided medical treatment to 3009 migrants through 271 Out Reach Sessions. HRGs have received Regular Medical Check-up & Counseling. 142 persons had HIV test.
