SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEPARTMENT

In the month of May Navjeevan Trust has taken the initiative to start with a new department **Social Entrepreneurship Dept.** The main aim to start with this department is to help women of SHG's to earn for their livelihood. In this month women has started making Papad in Jeevan Jyoth Ashram.



HEALTH DEPARTMENT

A) CLINIC SERVICE:

We provided quality health care services to **1160** rural and migrant people through our six rural health centers. We organized **10** general health camp for migrant industrial workers, total **236** workers benefitted. We coordinated diabetes check-up and physiotherapy camp for senior citizens, total **68** senior citizen benefitted.

B) CBCI-CARD RNTCP PROJECT:

We are implementing two TB Schemes namely TB Urban Slum and TB/HIV scheme in Rajkot city. During the month we screened **2480** people and out of them **145** TB suspected tested sputum and **19** CXR, Total **08 found TB Positive** and put on DOTS.

C) COMBATING HIV/AIDS:

Navjeevan Trust is covering 12300 MSM, FSW & Destination migrants who are vulnerable to getting HIV/STIs infections. During the month we covered **2915** migrants workers through **265** Out Reach Sessions, **623** HRGs received Regular Medical Check-up & Counseling and **164** HRGs tested for HIV.

D) MOTHER AND CHILD HEALTH:

Facilitated **FOUR** Village Health and Nutrition Day organized at Lodhika GIDC. Total 33 new ANC registered for Ante Natal Service, facilitated 14 institutional delivery, 02 Female Sterilization and 04 Copper-T insertion for spacing.

EDUCATION DEPARTMENT



Navjeevan Trust conducted Navjeevan Gujarati Olympiad (NGO) exam in 2014. 767 students from 91 schools had participated in the examination. Prize distribution ceremony was held at Navjeevan Office. Prizes were distributed by Bishop Jose Chittooparambil to all the winners. 1st prize winner was awarded with Laptop, 2nd prize winner was awarded with

Tablet, and 3rd prize winners were awarded with School bag. 188 students and 45 parents including teacher's attended the ceremony. Bishop Jose gave best wishes to all the students for the upcoming year and motivated them with a speech on importance of Education.

LIVELIHOOD DEPARTMENT

Gujarat Urban Livelihood Mission

GULM program has started in 4 centres Rajkot, Morbi, Surendranagar and Jamnagar of Skill Training. Total 160 students are enrolled.

- In Rajkot 20 students are enrolled in CNC Turning and 47 students in Sales Person.
- In Morbi 20 students got enrolled in Front Office cum Receptionist and 20 students in Sales Person.
- In Surendranagar 26 students got enrolled in Front Office cum Receptionist.
- In Jamnagar 27 students got enrolled in Arc & Gas Welding.

Gosai Kanavan Nathavan and Goswami Dharmendrapari Pravinpari from Tankara Taluka completed training at Navjeevan Technical Institute in DTP Course. They learned Gujarati typing and Data Entry at the Institute. At present they are working at Mamladar Kacheri. They made path for the other students also who finished their exams to earn and learn through data Entry for the Food Security project by Government. They are earning Rs 8000 a month along with the allowances.
