#### Health promotion programme

Navjeevan Trust had organized an Eye camp in collaboration with Lions Club Rajkot Mid town at Lodhika on 14<sup>th</sup>September 2014. 97 patients were examined by Dr.Mehta (Ophthalmologist) and his team. We have extended a great service to the deprived rural poor people of Lodhika.

Environment' by conducting a Rally and free Health Checkup(heart) Navjeevan staff, Christ Hospital staff and Students from Kansagara Mahila College and MSW Women's college took part in the rally. Around 700 people were a part of it and 492 people took the benefit of Heart Health Check up.

World Heart Day programme gave an awareness to the people regarding to cardiovascular diseases(CV). Some extend people understood that if they avoid four main risk factors like .Tobacco use, Unhealthy Diet, Physical inactivity and harmful use of Alcohol..

#### WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Navjeevan Trust Women empowerment department has formed a Federation of groups in order to make the SGH groups equal in social and economic conditions and for the sustainability of the groups. It plays a crucial role in this department. It covers social harmony across diverse communities, community action by SHG's and so on. Navjeevan Trust has conducted stake holder meeting at Lodika centre to sensitize people about activities of Navjeevan Trust and extended our support to the people at Lodika village.

Navjeevan Trust has conducted awareness programmes for diary famers and 2488 members of Gujarat (Surendranagar, Amreli, Junagadh, Kutch, Porabander and participated in 6 districts Bhavnagar.)

## LIVELIHOOD (Aajeevika Skill Development Programme)



Navjeevan Trust has initiated a Technical Training Programme adding more value to its social apostolate. This Programme is supported by Ministry of Rural Development to train 1920 Rural BPL youth for Entry level Employment. On 25<sup>th</sup> September 2014 Bishop Jose Chittooparambil inaugurated the first training centre at Rajkot and Bishop Gregory Karotemprel lighted the lamp. This program was witnessed by many fathers, sisters and well-wishers and 140 Trainees.

#### **EDUCATION**

Education department has conducted 110 Bal Mandal meetings and 1593 members has taken part in the meetings .The meeting was conducted to help students to make their future brighter. We have initiated Gujarati Olympiad program at Navjeevan Trust 542 names were registered for the same. During the last month 45 balmadals bas been formed in Sarpdad,Morbi,Maliya and Parnala.and Wakaner center\ conducted Sports Day for children. Essay writing Competition has been conducted in Chachana and 150students took part in it.

#### **Placement students**

15 students have joined us for the placement from .K.N Kansagra Mahila College, Shri Mahoshri Arvindh MSW College, Shri Creation College, Nirma College (Ahmedbad) H.N Shukla MSW College and Sri Aurobindo MSW college. They have successfully completed their field work. Best wishes to them.


#### Department of Disability
