## Department of Health

Navjeevan Trust, Rajkot is a pioneer organization in the field of HIV/AIDS. We have implemented three 'Targeted Intervention Projects' in partnership with Gujarat State AIDS Control Society, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of Gujarat. Under this project we are covering 12300 High Risk People of MSM, FSW & Destination Migrant Group.

- Organized **16 medical camp** in Industrial areas of Shaper veraval and **349** people benefited from the medical camp.
- **Under TB Awarness Programme** we have sensitized 169 people and 7 positive cases were found during the month.
- Two Advocacy Meeting has been conducted
- During the last month we have given medical service 1319 rural people from 6 Rural Dispensaries of different villages of Rajkot.
- Formed new Senior Citizen Club men at Lodhika and also facilitated monthly meeting of Women Senior citizen..
