

SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation **be an active**, **fully-initiated Catholic** (Confirmed). An **active** Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle and is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge or mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor). Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before their child's Baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on **the FIRST Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM.** Registration is required. Please contact Sr. Nadine 908-756-0633 x118 to register for the class or with any questions.

# Adventure in the Spirit

After the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles on Pentecost, they received the courage to follow God's will for them. They could not have imagined that they would travel the known world, going to the most unexpected of places. St. Peter ended up in Rome itself. St. Thomas went to India. Similarly, today when Catholics celebrate Confirmation, as our young people did this past Friday, the gifts of the Holy Spirit enable us to act out the purpose God has for our lives, both in the short term and the long term. Responding to the urging of the Holy Spirit in our lives always results in adventures we could not otherwise imagine. Some of these Pentecost moments are thrust upon us. Others are adventures we have the insight to seek out.

Last month two Sacred Heart parishioners, Gilbert and Beth Delacruz, went on pilgrimage to northern Spain and walked part of the Camino de Santiago. This spiritual adventure consists of walking a network of trails leading to the shrine of the apostle James in the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia in northwestern Spain. While the entire route is 500 miles, our intrepid pilgrims walked 100 miles in approximately a week. They visited little villages, prayed in old chapels, met



pilgrims from all over the world, and attended special pilgrim Masses every night in each town in which they stayed.

The act of walking miles each day becomes a spiritual pilgrimage when done in a spirit of prayer and faithful trust. The weather at this time of year in northern Spain can vary from rainy downpours to bright sunlight in a single day. The pilgrim trail is sometimes paved, sometimes not, and often uneven. Uphill and downhill, the trail challenges those young and old. Together Gilbert and Beth walked 221,329 steps. The path is not easy. They said they nearly gave up, but calling on the Holy Spirit, they reached the cathedral in Compostela. Beth explained, "Life indeed is not that easy! It has ups and down but if you focus, keep moving and put your trust and faith in Him, you will be triumphant!"

Arriving in Compostela, pilgrims visit the Cathedral where the bones of St. James the Great, son of Zebedee are believed to be buried. Pilgrims can venerate these relics. The Cathedral is also known for a massive censer weighing 176 pounds and just over 5 feet high. Swung from the cathedral ceiling across the nave of the church, the censer spreads the fragrant smoke of incense.

Partly as a way of commemorating this arduous pilgrimage, pilgrims on the Camino can obtain and carry a document called the credencial, which is also known as the pilgrim's passport. It is stamped with the official St. James stamp in each town a pilgrim stays. This document becomes proof to the Pilgrim's Office in Santiago that the journey was actually accomplished by the pilgrim. If the pilgrim has walked approximately 100 kilometers of the route, an official Compostela pilgrim certificate will be issued.

Why did Gilbert and Beth even want to embark on such a dramatic adventure? Sometimes to catch a glimpse of the transcendent in our lives, we have to take a radical break from the everyday. Covering distance on foot immerses one completely in the surroundings. At its most basic, walking the Camino puts one out in nature for days at a time. The physically arduous nature of walking a great distance is humbling, and gaining humility is crucial to getting closer to God.

We may not have the experience of the Holy Spirit that the apostles had on Pentecost, but the Holy Spirit still invites us to adventures in faith that can transform how we live our lives for Christ. —Louise Timko, *Director of Religious Education & Faith Formation*


